The Scotch Doubles 8 Ball League for the Winter Session ended this past September 2011. Twelve teams signed up for the double round session which was held on Sundays at Farringtons Bar in Pleasant Hill, Ca. and generated a total payout of \$6,407, which all went back to the participating teams.

The dominating team at the end was Leslie Bernardi and Rich Yoder. These duo are part of the same Open-Mix team. Leslie is also currently the Top Female Shooter in the DVP Open and Women's leagues, and the Champion of the 9 Ball Scotch Doubles League with Jared Williams.

Congratulations to them. They won 17 matches and lost 6 out of the 22 required. They also took top honors for "the most break and runs" with 8. They faced tough competition from Holly Robinson and Dave Gomez; last years scotch 8 Ball and 9 Ball champions as well as former champions Shawn and VJ Modelo. But in the end they would prevail.

These 3 teams competed elbow to elbow during the session and with one match left 2nd and 3rd spot were in the competition and pending on the results of that last match. This league is handicapped as all our leagues have a point system to make the top teams play their best always and the middle of the teams to have the same chances to top prizes. And for the less experienced teams to have a chance to also make head way on their standings. This league is a handicapped league. Based on the total number of individual games played and won divided by the total number of matches. It evens out the scale and forces top teams to play their best and earn their money. On a race to 5 the most handicap given would be 2 games.

At the end of it all first, first, second and third place got complicated when we ran into a 3 way tie which was decided by total of games won. When ever total games still results in a tie the total games lost is the deciding factor.
