

DIABLO VALLEY POOL LEAGUE

SCOTCH DOUBLES 8-BALL ACS

The Scotch Doubles 8-Ball League begins on Saturday November 7, 2009.

-The league will play two rounds round robin. (Each team plays against each team twice).

-This year we will be playing out of two locations one Farrington's Bar and second Cj's Bar.

-This league will be played on Saturday afternoons with a starting time of 3:00 pm on both locations; we will try to FOLLOW a schedule as much as possible.

-We will be very flexible for the November and December months due to holidays. But as of Jan 2010 we will start to push to follow matches per schedule.

-Both sponsors will honor our buy one get one free drink one as long as we follow the drink policy mainly with Farrington's Bar.

-All teams will get paid.

-A team will be a man and a woman with alternates allowed.

-Alternates DO NOT need to pay sponsor fee, they however are expected to pay \$10 whenever they play.

- ALL TEAMS WILL PLAY FOR TWO MATCHES TO ESTABLISH NEW AVERAGES.

-We will play a race to five, and the most handicap a team will give is 2 Games.

-Every team will play each other once, and whichever team wins the most games will win the league.

-No "ringers" will be allowed in our league. You are welcome to pick up the best player available as long as he is part of the league from day one. NO TOP GUNS after half session.

- No new alternates in the last 4 weeks of league, only the people that have substituted before. **(Each case of substitution will considered by the league runners).**

-The team that wins the most round points/matches will win the league. If there is a tie, then we will go to the most number of games won, then the less number of losses and if still tie we will have a tie breaker.

-Re-schedules will be allowed to make sure that each round point is earned on the pool table.

-No foul play, sandbagging, or any kind of dishonest behavior will be allowed or tolerated by the league.

- When filling out the score sheets all teams must write the needed information and sign the score sheet. Team #, the amount of money paid, break and runs noted clearly, and most important the captain of each team must sign the score sheet in order to verify the numbers that are being turned into the league.

-This league will qualify players to participate with ACS tournaments.

- DVPL reserves the right to deny play to anyone who shows unsportsmanlike behavior, either by cheating, sharking, being rude, owing money, throwing balls around, etc, etc. Any money paid will stay in the pot.

-Players will receive one Verbal warning for first offense, for the second offense Team will lose a Round point, for 3rd and final offense team will not be able to participate any longer and any money paid will stay in the pot.

GUIDELINES

This league suggests the following guidelines for play. However, we welcome suggestions and constructive criticism. Please read them carefully.

1. Alternating team brakes. No "coaching" allowed. One time out allowed per game. Mark it on the score sheet to make sure there are no mistakes (T/O).
2. There is a \$50 Sponsorship money per PLAYER, and \$10 per PLAYER per match played a night.
3. The roster sheets handed out with the folder on the second week should be turned in so we can sanction the league ASAP.

4. This will be a handicapped league. It has been stated since the early stages of the league. The first two weeks of league the teams will play scratch (no handicap).
5. For the third week an average of the team will be obtained by counting the number of games won - number of games lost divided by the total number of matches played by the team. **Team average = $\frac{gW-gL}{T \text{ matches}}$**
6. Alternates are allowed to come in but they need to establish an average. **If a team is to receive handicap games and a new alternate comes into the league, this team will have to forfeit those games.**
7. The handicap will be obtained by subtracting the average of the lower team from the higher team. The number of games to be given will be read from the Handicap Chart of the stats.
8. If handicap sits between 1.5 and 1.6 1 game will be awarded.
9. One Round Point will be equivalent to a match won.
10. At the end of the season we will have a "Bonus Round Tourney". Money will be set aside from the payout for this as well as an entry fee collected on that day from each team that plays. The teams that finish in the top $\frac{1}{2}$ of the standings will have a round robin tourney to win their allocated money, and the teams that finish in the bottom $\frac{1}{2}$ will have their own tourney to win their allocated money. We will play a race to three and the handicap will still apply. This will give us the opportunity to pay the cash to all teams.
11. Any disputes or disagreements should be directed to Cony-Tina Mendoza. If there is disagreement on a call either someone will back down or simply the game will be re-racked. No need to waste time.
12. Please have someone watch a close play to avoid conflicts.
